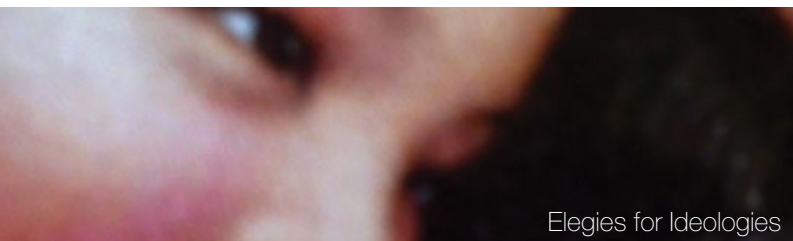


EXPERIMENTS IN TIME: ARTISTS' DOCUMENTARY

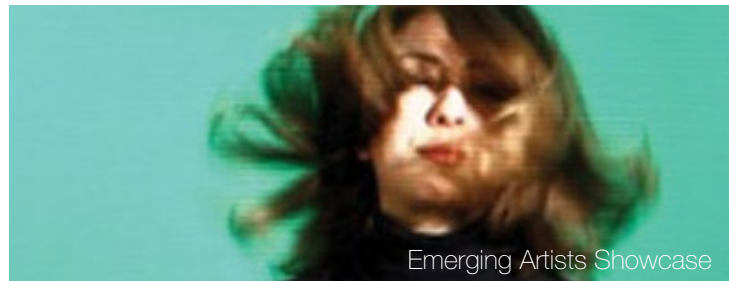
